It is intended to ensure that the public is aware of the known costs associated with a proposed collective bargaining agreement.

Cost:

The terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Bellevue Education Association (BEA) stipulates that increases to Salaries in FY 2022/23 be benchmarked against the Statutory Cost of Living Allocation Adjustment (COLA) as determined by the California Department of Education for that year (6.56% per the FY 2022/23 Adopted State Budget) in addition to an increase to the District's employer contribution to health and wellness benefits of \$1000 (annual).

It is intended to ensure that the public is aware of the known costs associated with a proposed collective bargaining agreement.

Cost:

The terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Classified School Employees Association (CSEA) stipulates that increases to said salaries and benefits for represented Classified Employees be aligned with the settled salary and benefits terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Bellevue Education Association (BEA). The terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Bellevue Education Association in turn stipulates that increases to Salaries in FY 2022/23 be benchmarked against the Statutory Cost of Living Allocation Adjustment (COLA) as determined by the California Department of Education for that year (6.56% per the FY 2022/23 Adopted State Budget) in addition to an increase to the District's employer contribution to health and wellness benefits of \$1000 (annual).

The calculated impact to the FY 2022/23 Budget will be outlined under a separate cover.

Recommended Action:

Review and Approve based on the terms of the agreement and the adopted State Budget.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DreamBox Learning, Inc. (“**DreamBox Learning**”) offers software products and services that provide personalized math instruction in an engaging environment for students. 3. SERVICES

All Professional Development will be utilized during the term of the Order Form. Professional Development not utilized during the term of the Order Form will be forfeited.

3.2 Cancellation.

(a) On-site Professional Development canceled within 15 business days of the scheduled on-site visit will result in forfeiture. DreamBox Learning shall have no obligation to reschedule on-site. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if on-site visit is canceled due to acts of God, government regulations, disaster, or strikes DreamBox will work in good faith with the Customer to reschedule.

(b) Webinars canceled within 3 business days of the scheduled webinar will result in forfeiture. DreamBox Learning shall have no obligation to reschedule the webinar.
