

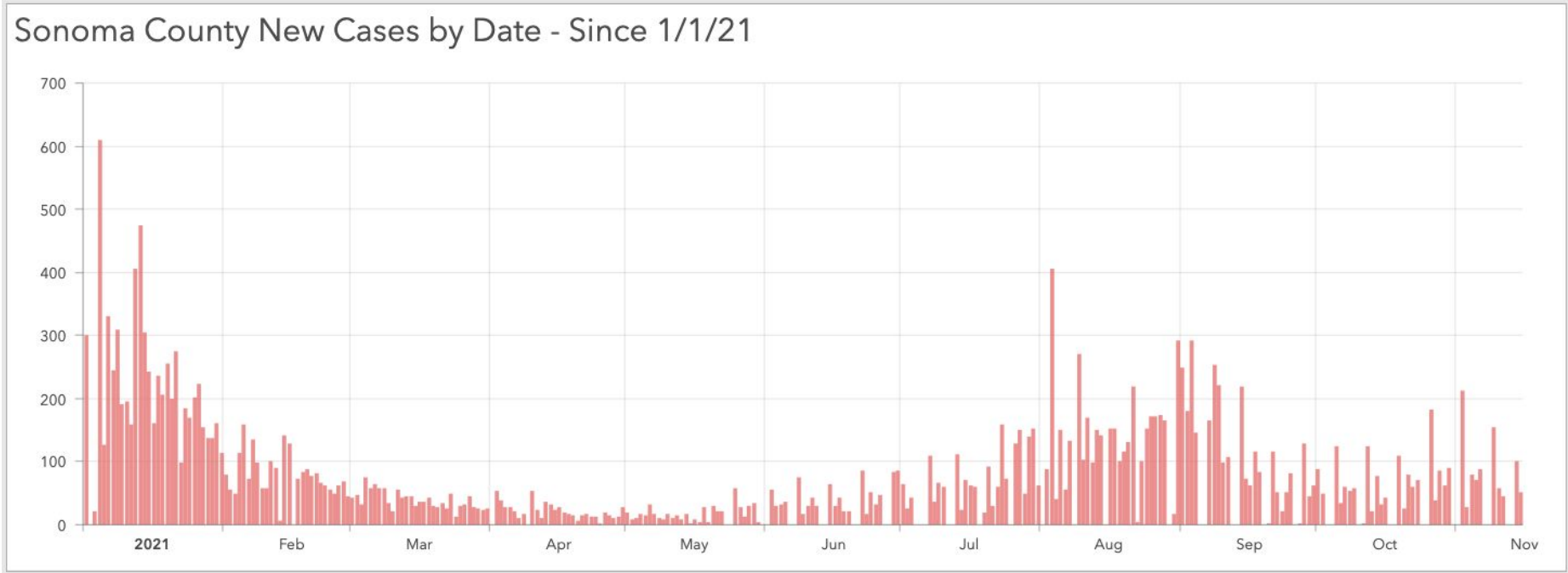

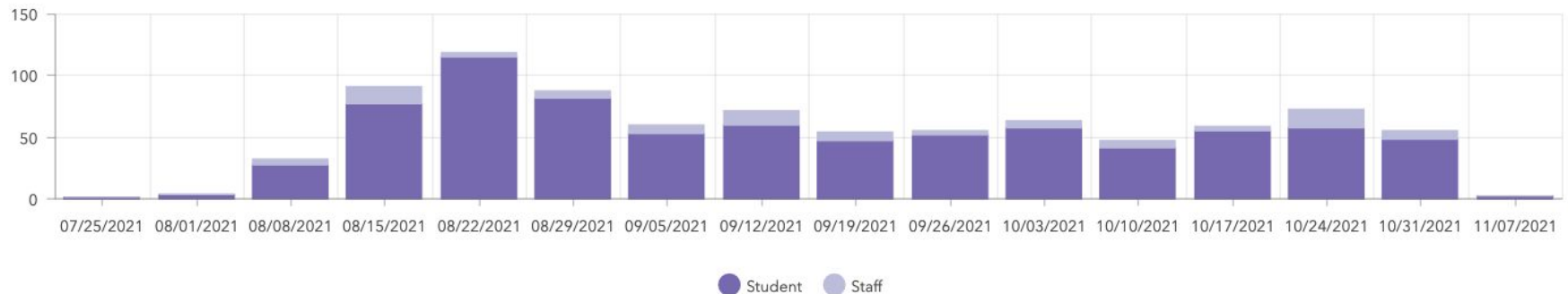

Trends in Numbers of Student and Staff COVID-19 Cases by Week

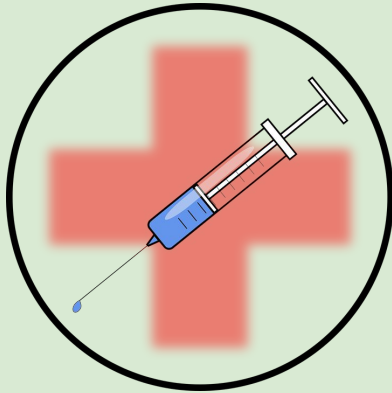




Update on COVID Support

- Testing for extra-curricular activities is up and running

Vaccination Information



Timeline

Late September: Kickoff meeting with school districts

Early-mid October: SCOE holds planning meetings with County Health team to identify clinics and outreach strategies, begin planning meetings/webinars with pediatricians

Late October: Hold first joint webinars with the county

Late October: Release communications packet to school districts

Early November: Estimated release of first doses

Kawana Vaccine Clinic

- Vaccination clinic was held at Kawana today, 2:30 - 5:30 pm
- There was line of at least 30 families at 2:30
- Thank you to Kawana Springs Principal, Denise McCullough, for coordinating with Fox Home Health and the County
- The next vaccination clinic will be December 7, 2021 2:30 to 5:30 pm
- Today, 150 vaccination shots were administered

Vaccine Requirements

- SCOE has received clarification from Governor Newsom's office that the State Mandate for COVID-19 Vaccination is **anticipated to occur in July 2022** in time for the start of school Fall of 2022-23.
- As additional information becomes available, SCOE will work with County Health to provide recommendations and guidelines for public, private and charter schools in the County to assist with a smooth transition.
- BUSD has a 91% vaccination rate among staff.
