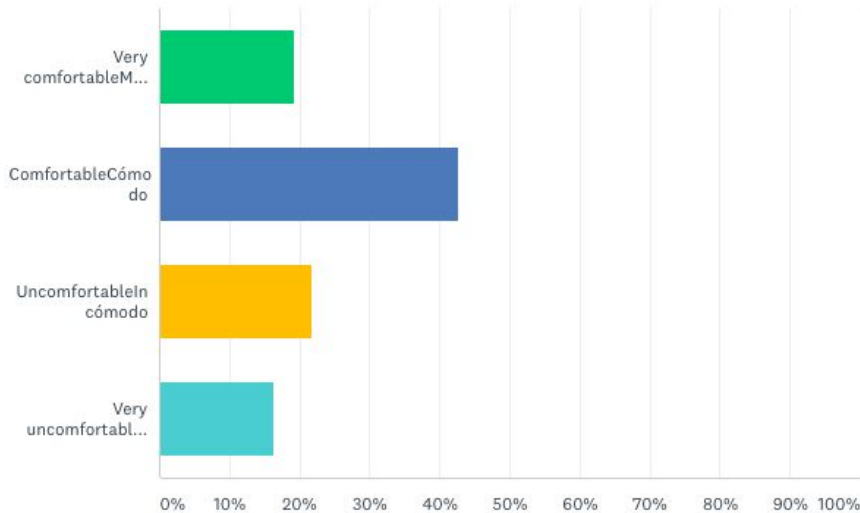

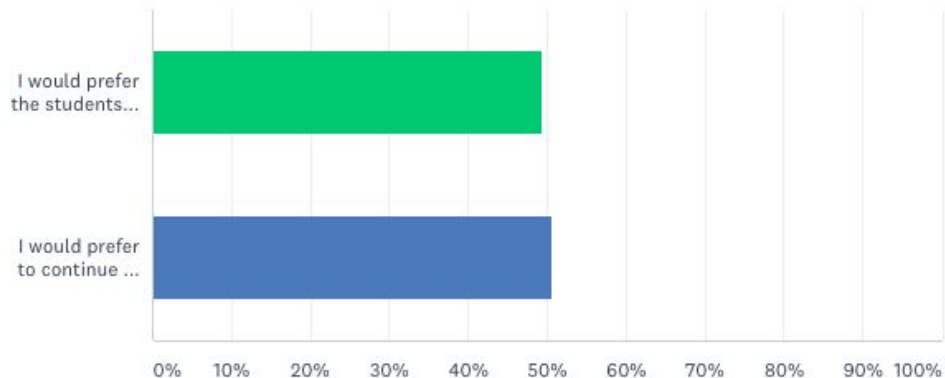

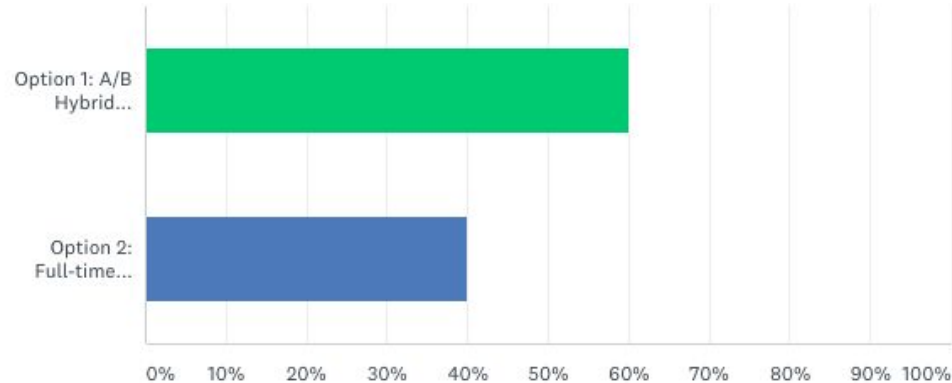

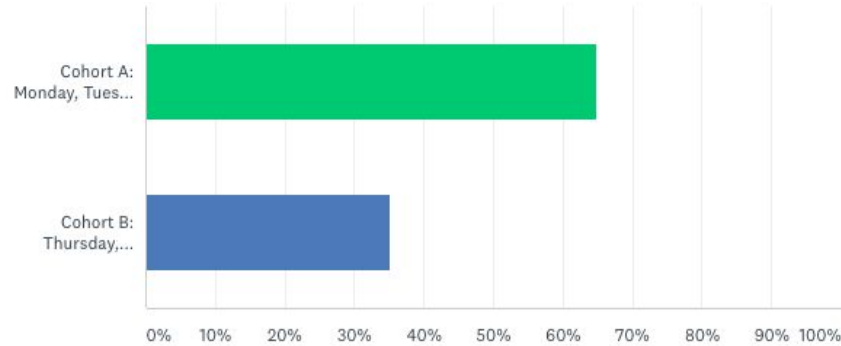

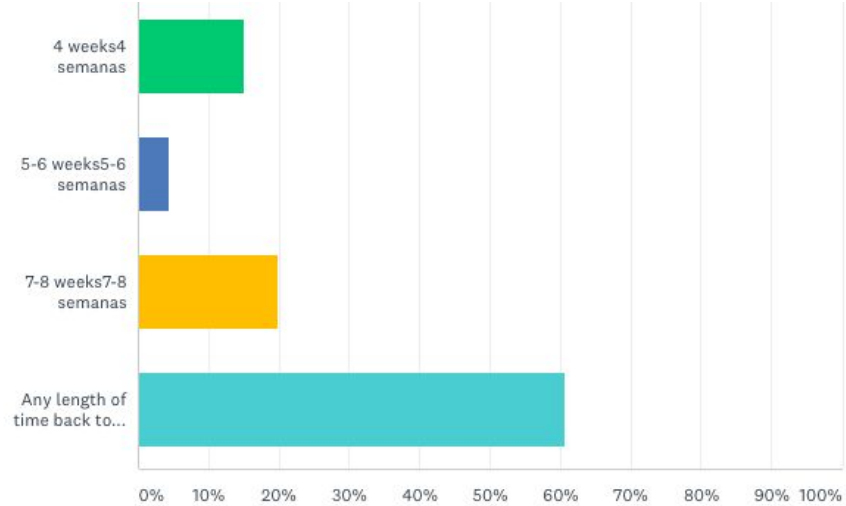

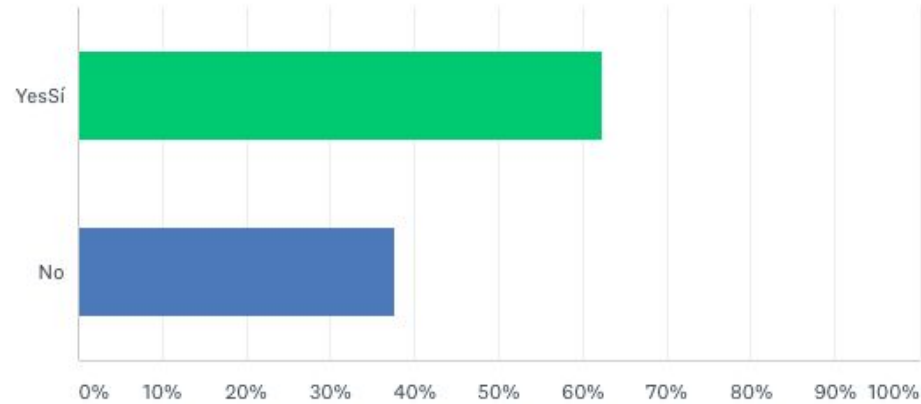

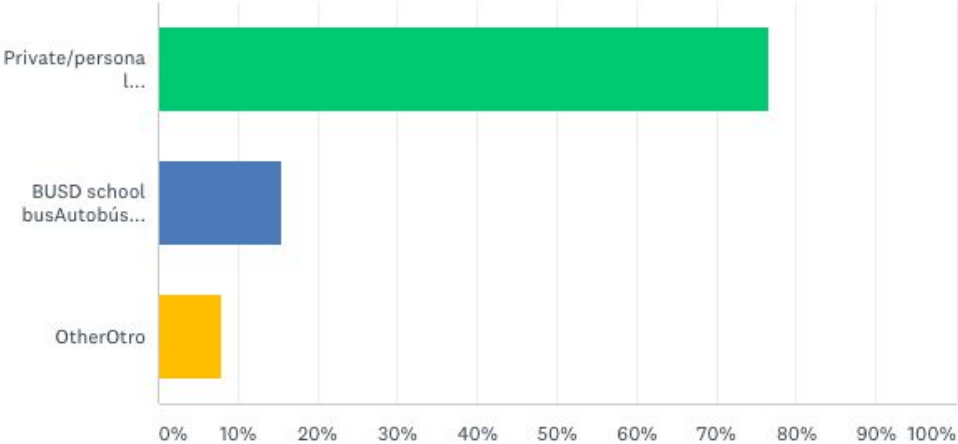


11) If available, would you send your child to a summer school program that concentrated on accelerating learning:

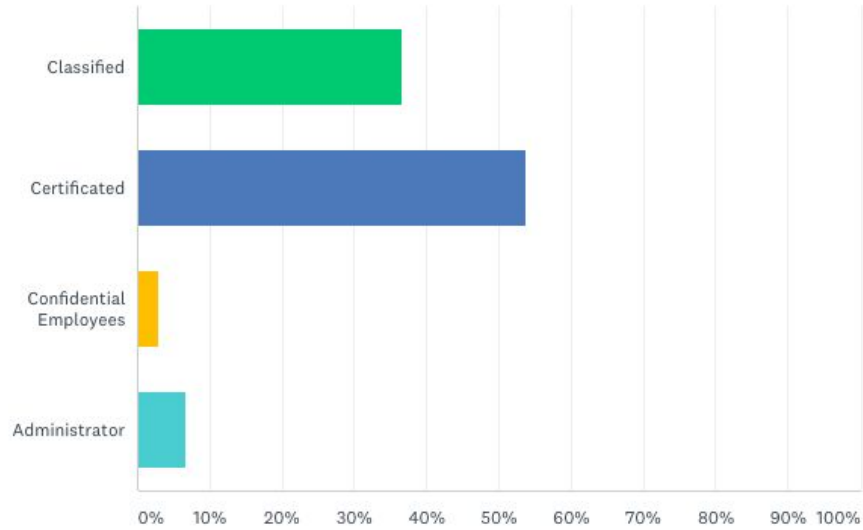

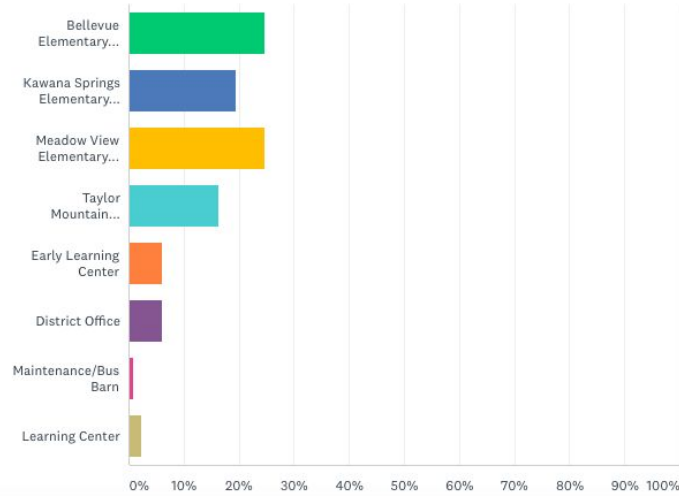

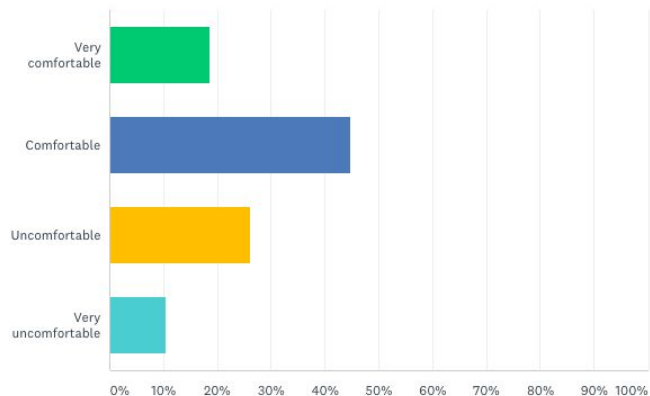

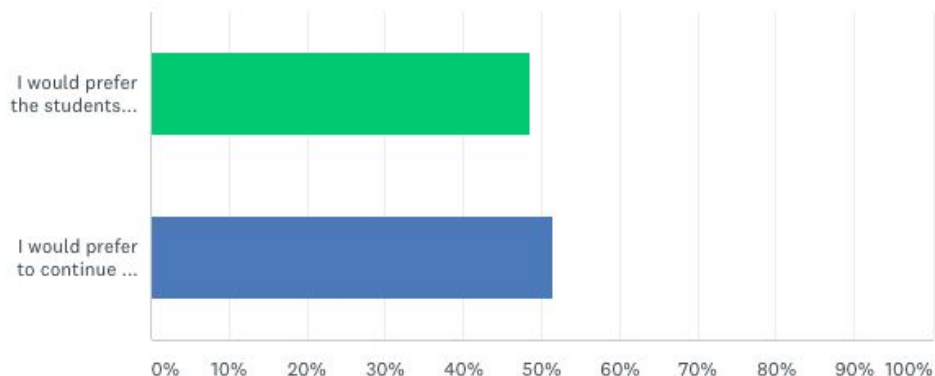

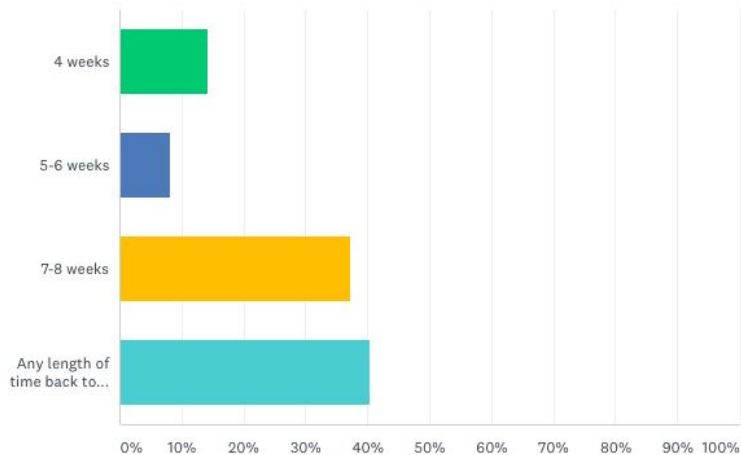

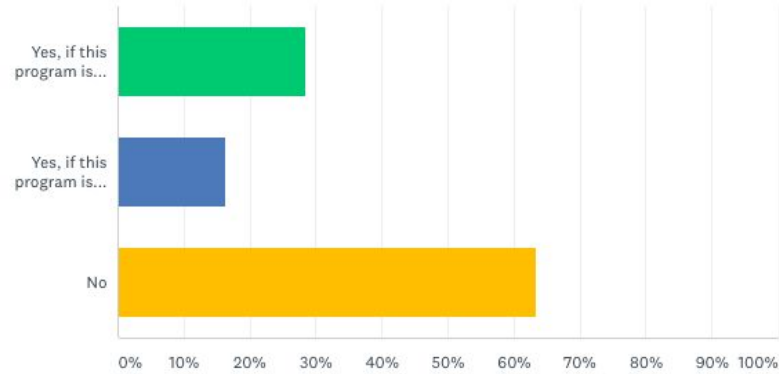

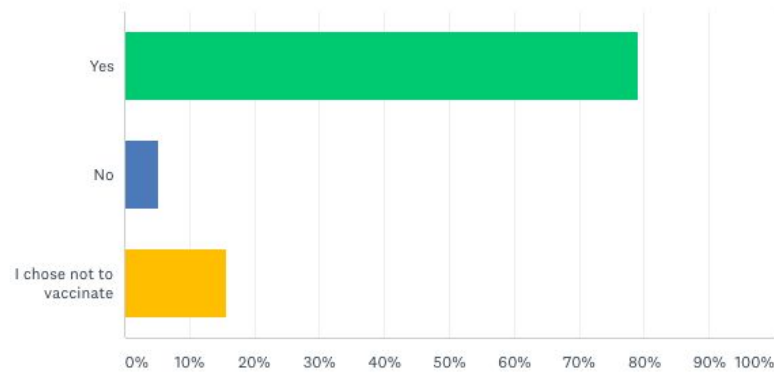

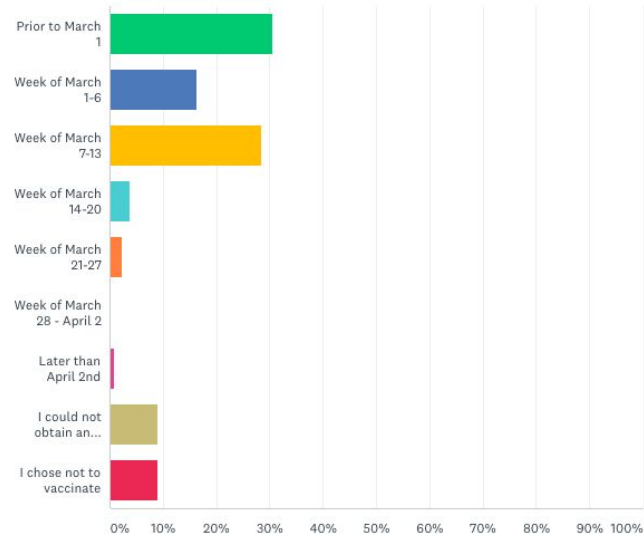

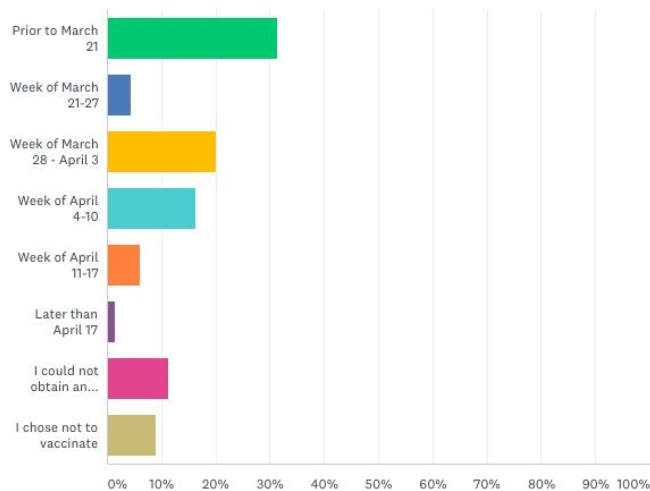

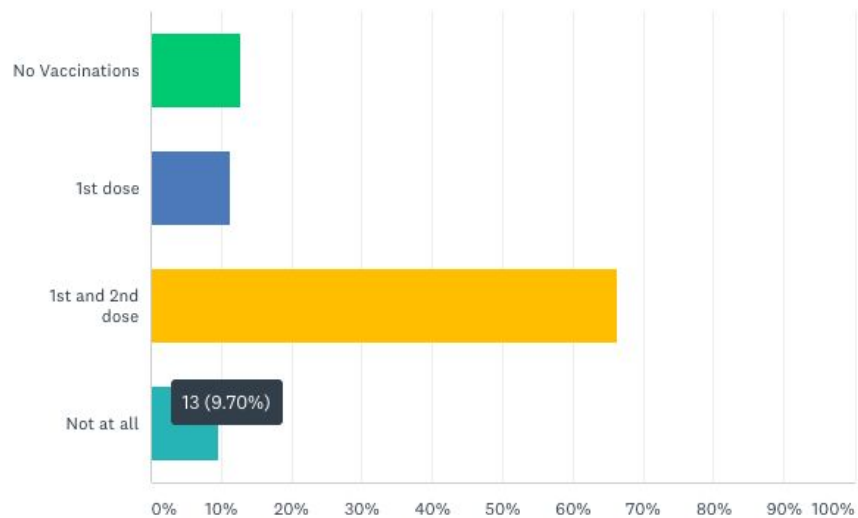

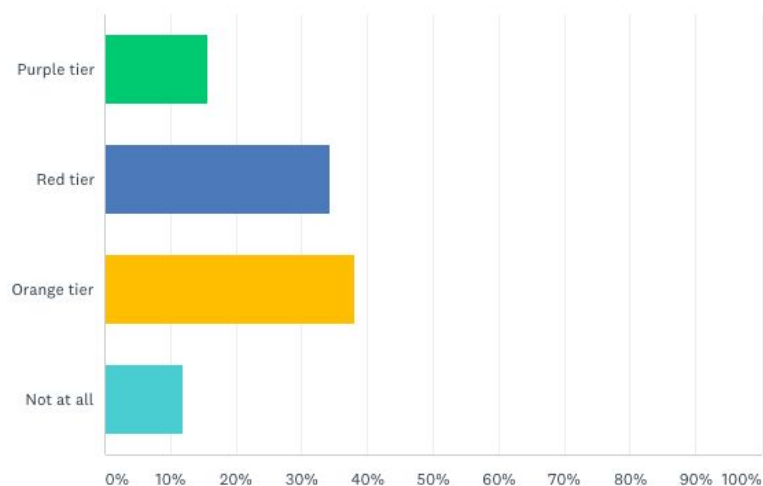
